*****NEW!!!***** We will have a **ROYALTY DIVISION** this year – The Royalty Division is for anyone who has already qualified in a Princess of NC Preliminary for the 2009 State Pageant and would like to participate in the pageant for practice & receive judge’s scores. The judges will not know who will be in the Royalty Division and who is competing for a title. **This is not a crowned title**, but all Royalty Division participants will receive a gift. This is a non-binding title and winners will receive monies off towards their State fees. *Note - Open to reigning preliminary queens ONLY! Contestants competing in royalty divisions will compete in the same areas of competition as non-title holders. Award amounts for fees off to the State Pageant will be determined by the number of entries received minus expenses ~ awards (fees off) will be mailed directly to the State pageant office to be applied to the winners State fees.*

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

BEAUTY (Mandatory) – Ages 0-9 wear a short pageant dress. Ages 10 and up must wear a long pageant gown. Pageant dresses may be as simple or glitzy as you like, but PLEASE remember to keep the dress age appropriate. The contestant will be judged on their natural beauty, not the actual pageant dress.

CASUAL WEAR (Mandatory) – Must be “OFF THE RACK”.....NO Custom Outfits, all original tags sewn into garment must remain intact, can be altered to fit, no bare mid-drifts, may add embellishments (stones, sequins, etc...) – no material restrictions. *****BEST CASUAL WEAR (Optional) will be judged on the Casual Wear Outfit Only.*****

PRIVATE INTERVIEW (Mandatory) – Ages 7 and up. Questions will come from what you provide on the Contestant Form. Interviews will be 3 minutes. **Attire should be appropriate for an interview.**

SLEEPWEAR (Optional Ages 0-6) must be age appropriate. Small carry-on props are allowed.

BEST DRESS (Optional) – contestant is judged on pageant dress ONLY during Beauty Competition..

SWIMWEAR (Optional) – Swimsuit must be a **one piece** and chosen in good taste. (Rings, strings, ribbon, connecting a top and bottom are NOT considered a one piece). Shoes are optional and should be taupe or clear.

TALENT (Optional ages 0-6 yrs – ***Mandatory for 7 and Up. for Overall Supreme title***) – CD’s are preferred, but cassettes are accepted. All music must be cued with only one song on the tape/CD!! **Talent should be no longer than 3 minutes!** All tapes/CD’s must be marked with the contestant’s name, title of the song, and what their talent is (dance, singing, etc.) All Music must be turned in during rehearsal or registration!! No props allowed!

PHOTOGENIC (Optional) – 5x7 or 8x10 Black & White or Color photos placed in a plastic sleeve/clear cover. NO FRAMES! Natural Photos! Make-up is allowed but should only be enough for photographic needs. Natural photo's mean no enhancements, or retouching is allowed but photo's must be done professionally! Label back of photo with contestant’s name and age division. **Head and/or Head & Shoulder Shots Only.**
Please have ALL PHOTOS turned in during REGISTRATION!!

Spirit Queen – All contestants are able to run for the Spirit Queen by collecting penny votes from family and friends. A large portion of this money will be donated to a local charity in Davidson County. Only one contestant who has received the most votes will win. You can start now by collecting votes and have them turned in by the night of Rehearsal. The winner will receive a crown and a sash. She will reign with the Princess of Davidson County Court.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Non-Refundable: This pageant is non-refundable except at the director's discretion. All scores will be given out immediately following crowning. Photogenic pictures, talent tapes/CD's and scores may be picked up at the auditors' table after the pageant is over. Judges decisions are final. Bad sportsmanship from contestants, parents, or spectators will not be tolerated and could result in the contestant being disqualified.

**There will be a \$25 fee for all Returned Checks.

Still shot cameras will NOT BE ALLOWED during the actual program. However, video camera's WILL be allowed – you may set up towards the back of the auditorium.

Be on time: Please be on time for all competitions. No competition will begin early, however it is wise to be backstage and lined up 10 minutes before each competition begins. There will be several staff members backstage that will know exactly what time each event starts and will help remind you throughout the day. There are no exceptions for those that are late for their particular competitions.

Judging Criteria: Judges will be informed to look for a more “natural beauty”. This doesn’t mean without make-up! Just remember a little makeup goes a long way! Clothes, Hair and Make-up are also important but please do not feel that you need to purchase an expensive dress, or have **professional** hair and make-up in order to participate in this pageant. The Princess of Davidson County Pageant is looking for natural beauties.

Dressing Areas: Time and electrical outlets may be in short supply. Please come as ready as possible before arriving. ***If you have a hair/makeup person coming with you, please let the director know ASAP.***

Scores: Score sheets, talent music and pictures may be picked up at the auditors table immediately following crowning. You must turn in your Contestant Number in order to receive scores.

Please remember that this experience should be positive, fun and memorable for everyone. Please show good sportsmanship to the contestants as well as parents and staff of the Princess of Davidson County Pageant. We look forward to working with you!

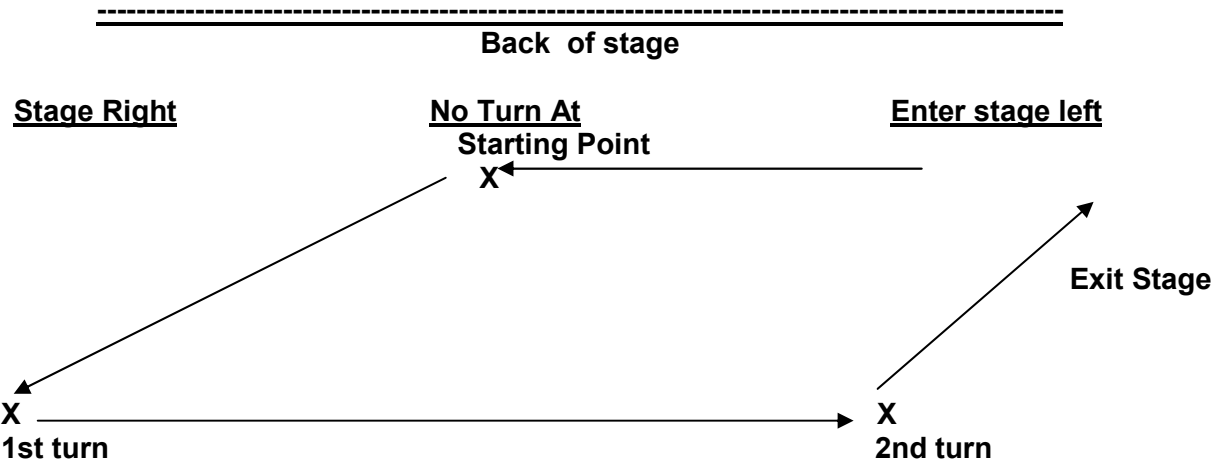
